#### **Events**

February saw lots of work taster visits for Year 10. Students built a robotic arm in an engineering visit, explored early years careers in a nursery setting and visited the armed forces, forensics, dog unit and drone departments at Bloxwich Police Station's Open Day. Year 13 Philosophy students attended an A Level masterclass at Coventry Cathedral, hosted by leading author Peter Vardy. The 7<sup>th</sup> February was Safer Internet Day. This year's theme was 'Want to talk about it? Making space for conversations about life online'. 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> February was Children's Mental Health Week. 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# **Academy Routines**

# <u>Uniform</u>

We have a strict, but simple, uniform policy at the academy. We do not permit trainers, short skirts or tight trousers to be worn. We are a formal place of work; therefore, the expectation is that students have:

- Black skirts of an appropriate length.
- Black trousers (appropriate style).
- Blazers with the academy badge.
- Academy ties for all students (Years 7-11).
- Formal black shoes (no trainers/sports makes).

The only jewellery permitted is one pair of stud earrings and one nose stud.

### <u>Equipment</u>

Students need adequate stationery for their school day. This includes blue or black pens, green pen, pencil, ruler, rubber, pencil sharpener and a calculator. Many students find having their own glue stick and highlighters of benefit.

# Mobile Phones

Whilst students may carry a mobile phone in their bag, this is at their own risk. Mobile phones/earphones & other devices are not permitted in lessons and will be confiscated.

#### **Behaviour**

We expect our students to be ready, be respectful and be responsible. Good behaviour is essential for effective learning to take place. Detentions are issued for students who are late and/or disrupt learning.
