Attendance to the academy is of huge important. There is a clear link between poor attendance at school and lower academic achievement. We therefore expect holidays to be taken outside of term time and routine appointments to be taken outside of the academy day. A two week holiday taken during term time means the highest attendance that can be achieved is 94.7%. Lost learning time impedes on a student's progress. All student absences should be reported to the school by 8am.
