Dear Parents/Carers

We are now approaching the end of the first term of a very important year for our Year 11 students. They have already sat mock examinations and have been applying for places on their chosen courses for next year. Students' mock examination results will play a vital role in shaping their individual journey with us for their remaining time Year 11.

Please find enclosed the following information about your child's current academic achievement.

1) A statement of mock examination results

The grades that your child achieved in each of their mock examinations. (Please note: Product Design, GCSE Art and BTEC qualification subjects did not sit a mock examination.)

2) A progress report detailing the following information about your child's current academic attainment and expected outcomes in Year 11.

Target Grade – This is the minimum grade that your child should be aiming to achieve in each subject at the end of Year 11.

Forecast Grade – Based on the recent assessments that your child has completed, this is the grade that their teacher predicts they will achieve at the end of Year 11. For GCSE subjects this is a 9-1 scale. An overview of the grading for BTEC subjects is below:

*2 - Level 2 Distinction Star

D2 - Level 2 Distinction

M2 - Level 2 Merit

P2 – Level 2 Pass (grade 4 equivalent)

(*1, D1, M1 and P1 are Level 1 grades)

Targets – Three subject specific comments that give individual information about how to improve in that subject.

BFL Score – Teachers enter a Behaviour for Learning score that reflects our values of being ready, respectful and responsible. Your child will be awarded a 1 if they always display these positive behaviours, 2 for most of the time, 3 for sometimes and 4 for rarely.
